

Changing Images in Slideshows

Photos for the slideshows are kept in the wwwroot folder in individual folders for each slide show eg. 'apart1-slide' folder, 'contact-slide' folder, etc.

To make changes to the website you have to upload them. Open your FTP client program (Refer HowUploadFiles for how to upload to the web)

The slideshows are set up so they will find & show jpgs by number. so If you name a photo 1.jpg & put it in a particular slide folder it will appear first, followed by 2.jpg, 3.jpg, 4.jpg, 5.jpg, 6.jpg.

So to replace a photo with a new one just make it the same name at the right size in the right slide folder

Open the new image in Photoshop or your photo editing software

Change the size of landscape images to 400 pixels wide 72 dpi.

Change the size of portrait images 400 pixels high 72 dpi.

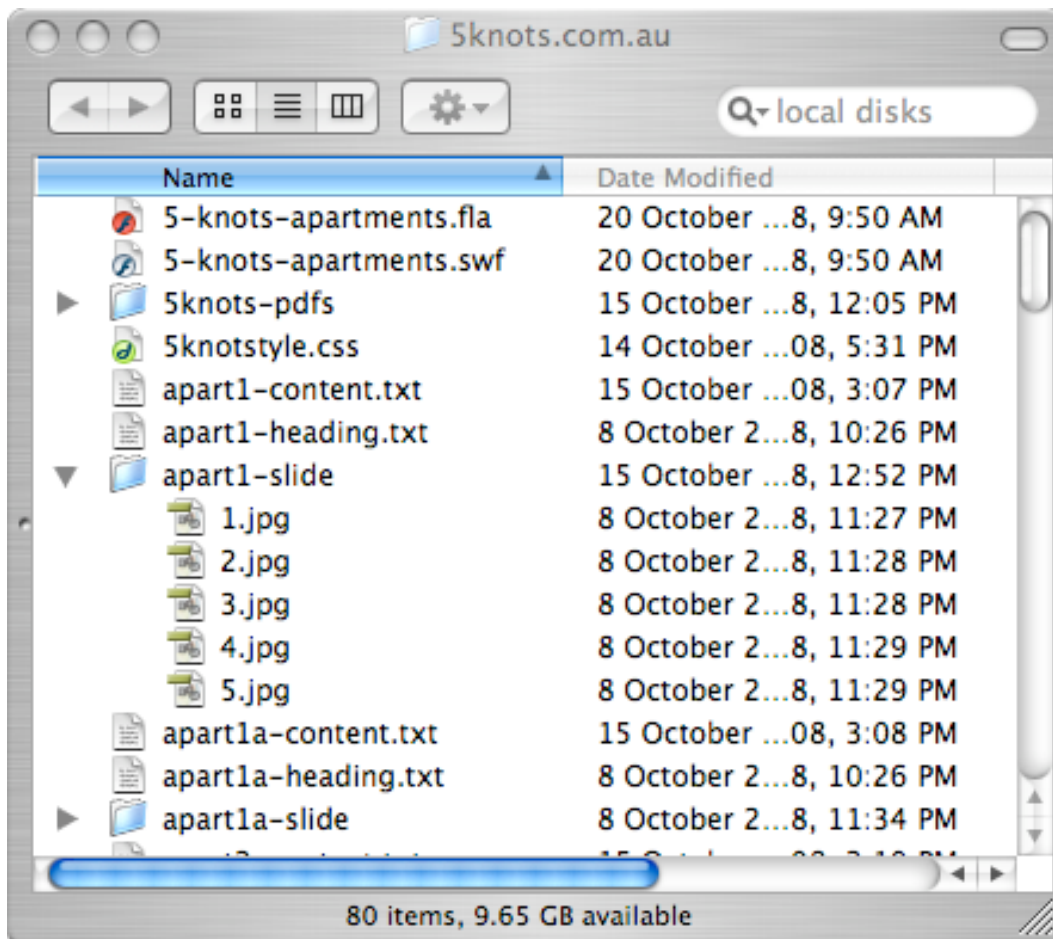
Save for web as a high quality jpeg with a number as the file name eg. 1.jpg

Try to keep image sizes to around 30K so they don't take too long to load, depending on the photo medium quality jpeg might be suitable if it looks ok.

Save the photo into its folder eg. apartment 1 images go into 'apart1-slide' folder.

Most of the slide folder names are self explanatory, other than start is home.

Take care you put in the right folder.

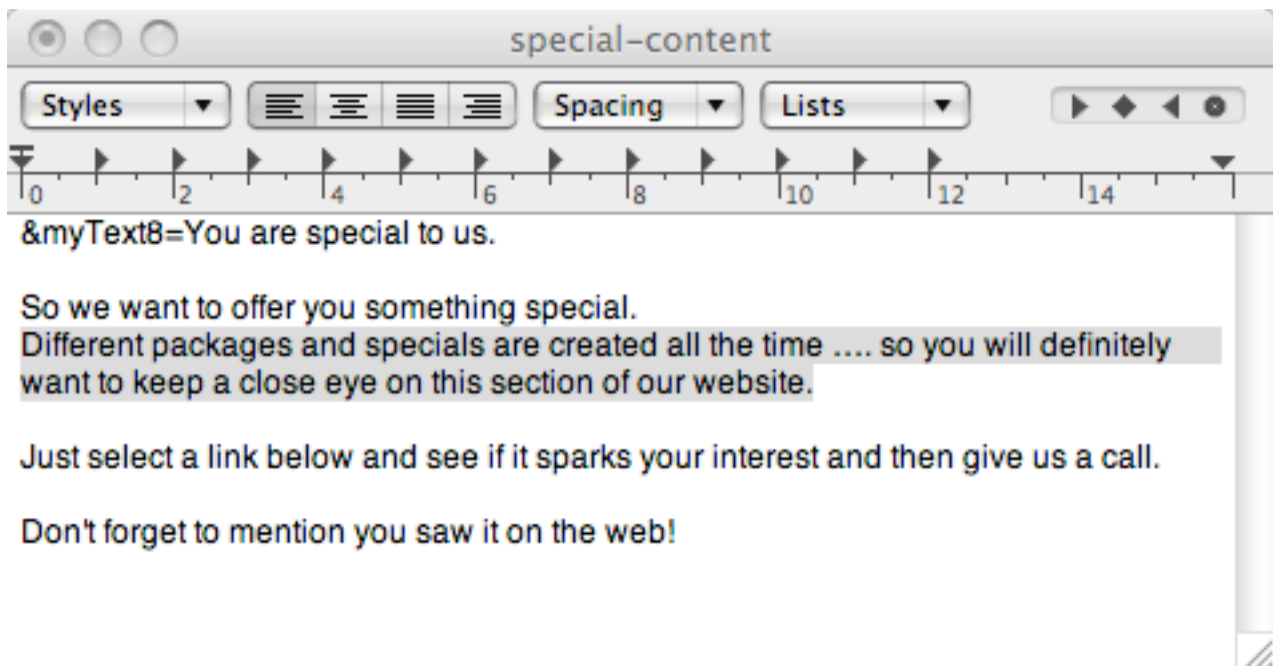
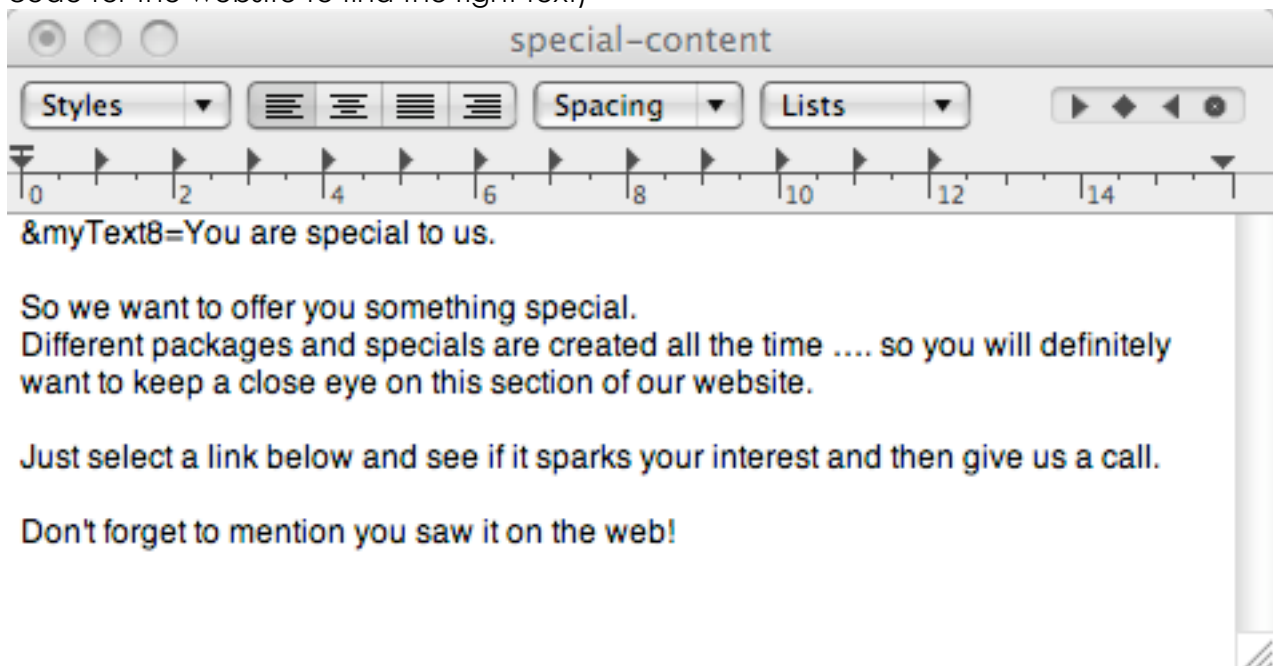


Changing / Adding Text

Text is in individual text files for each page. There is a heading eg. 'special-heading.txt' & a content eg. 'special-content.txt' text file. If you open any of these, make changes to the text & then upload them to the web, the changes should appear on that page.

To make changes to the website you have to upload them. Open your FTP client program (Refer HowUploadFiles for how to upload to the web)

Note; Don't change the first bit of text up to the = sign unchanged eg. &myText8= (this is code for the website to find the right text)



Highlight what you want to change & type the changes.
